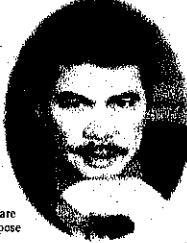

But he does have some advice to his fellow FILAMs aspiring for public office. "Integrity is important," he said and explained, "we should always deal with people professionally—alam mo naman

He is also active in social and economic activities, being part of civic organizations like the Lions Club, where he was the first non-white to be awarded as Lion of the Year. Satorre hopes to see the FILAMs to be more united. Again, he reiterated the value of perseverance and hard work, plus the effort to be more involved. "Take time to participate, to volunteer...we should set aside our 'crab mentality' and focus on how to help out the community." ■
